This sample poster...

...is based on a three-column design. You can change that in the poster options. Poster content is arranged in boxes that may span several columns, e.g. two for this box... ... or just one column...

University

Logo

...for this box

Horizontal arrangement...

... of boxes is done by specifying the first column of the box and its span.

Vertical arrangement...

...can be achieved in two ways:

- either you specify a vertical alignment in a predefined grid (e.g. 0.2 for this box)
- or you specify a box to be below another box. In this case, make sure that you always indicate the name of the lowest box should still be placed above the current box.

The backgrounds...

of the poster, of the header, and of the text boxes can be changed. They can be shaded (like the background of this poster), uniformly colored (like the header boxes), or empty (like all of these boxes except of one).
